Dear Parent / Carer

As you will have noted from the media, the situation regarding COVID-19 continues to evolve rapidly. As a school we have been putting plans in place to ensure that home learning can take place. Many staff have already issued materials to their classes. I appreciate that the short notice closure to our BGE pupils has resulted that in some cases this was not possible, and we are looking at ways of distributing such material. Thank you for your patience with this.

SQA Update

You will be aware by now that the decision has been made to cancel this year's SQA Exams in April and May. I have asked for clarification on the completion of coursework beyond tomorrow, given that schools will be closed from tomorrow afternoon to pupils. You will be aware that this is a rapidly ever changing situation and I will update you when I know more.

Our young people have worked hard to complete courses and assessments and my advice would be that although there will be no exams this year, they should continue to focus on learning and their next steps. Staff will be in school tomorrow to discuss any worries that our young people may have.

Current learning opportunities have been made available through the following channels:

GLOW TEAMS this is where a class Team has been set up and work will be made available for pupils. This is also a secure way for pupils to chat with their teacher and each other. I would like to remind you all that this facility is regularly monitored and that it should only be used for school use.

GLOW TILE each faculty has a tile under the Turriff Academy tile on GLOW and pupils can also be directed to work from this folder according to class and year group.

GLOW e-mail pupils can email staff via their GLOW e-mail (found in Office 365) Pupils should take care only to e-mail staff from Turriff Academy. Staff can also e-mail pupils in this way.

GLOW - Accelerated Reader – S1 Pupils

All S1 pupils at Turriff Academy are able to continue with Accelerated Reader at home. You can go to www.ARbookfind.co.uk to search for books you may have at home. Once pupils have finished reading their book, they then take a quiz to test their comprehension. There is a tile on GLOW for Accelerated Reader.
