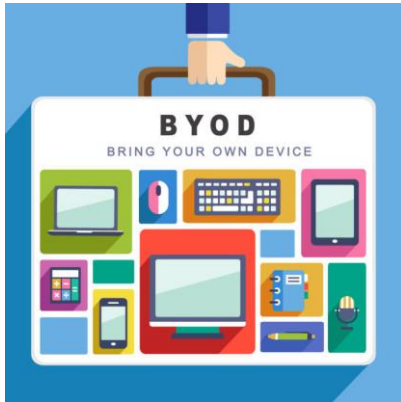

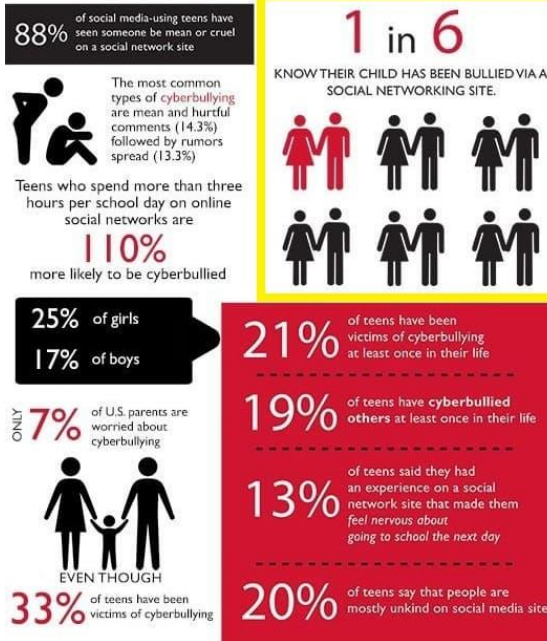
CYBERBULLYING
