

Secondary School Pupils COVID-19 Information Toolkit



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Introduction

It's been a confusing and difficult time for all of us, but especially for secondary school students who have not only faced disruption to their routine but also their education. After a period of online learning, they're now able to return to school for face-to-face learning, a welcome step but one that's accompanied by a number of additional considerations and measures designed to ensure everyone's safety.

As secondary school students physically return to school, it's important they're well informed about any changes they can expect and the guidelines they need to follow. This relates to guidelines both inside and outside of school, travelling safely, the impact of COVID-19 on their exams, and new COVID-19 testing, which is now being made available.

This toolkit is designed to address some of the key information that will help prepare students and keep them safe as they transition to in-school learning once again. You can help by sharing these messages with young people through your social channels.
