Why Accounting?

Accountants help organisations to succeed. They develop effective accounting procedures and provide financial information to management.

A knowledge of Accounting can open many doors in the job market, including careers in finance, IT consulting, tax planning and management consulting. In addition the course will help pupils develop skills to help them manage their personal finances.

The course has three compulsory units, plus an added value unit .

- Preparing Financial Accounting Information
- Preparing Management Accounting Information
- Analysing Accounting Information
- Added Value Unit: Accounting Practical Activity



<u>ASSESSMENT</u>

Assessment is by continuous assessment throughout the course and also by completion of an exam and an assignment both are externally marked by the SQA..

The course assessment has two components:

- a question paper (100 marks)
- an accounting related assignment (50 marks
