- Question Paper (50 marks)

The Assessment requires pupils to demonstrate complex IT skills using Word Processing, Spreadsheets, Databases and Desk top Publishing and apply them in the context of managing the organisation of an event.

The Question paper requires the integration of learning and knowledge and understanding from throughout the course.

Both are externally marked by the SQA.
